**PRIVACY ACT NOTICE**

**Authority:** 49 U.S.C. §114 authorizes the collection of this information.

**Purpose:** DHS will use this information to conduct a security threat assessment on airport employees and other personnel, or applicants, who work in or have unescorted access to the air operations area, secured area, sterile area, SIDA, or any area for which the airport has issued a personnel identification media.

**Routine Uses:** The information will be used by and disclosed to DHS personnel and contractors or other agents who need the information to assist in activities related to aviation security. Additionally, DHS may share the information with facility operators, law enforcement or other government agencies as necessary to respond to potential or actual threats to transportation security, or pursuant to its published Privacy Act system of records notice.

However, failure to furnish the requested information may delay or prevent the completion of your security threat assessment, which may prevent your access to the air operations area, secured area, sterile area, SIDA, or other area or purpose for which personnel identification media are issued.

#### List A

##### Documents that Establish Both Identity and Employment Eligibility

1. U.S. Passport (unexpired or expired)
2. Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (USCIS Form N-560 or N-561)
3. Certificate of Naturalization (USCIS Form N-550 or N-570)
4. Unexpired foreign passport, with I-551 stamp or attached Form I-94 indicating unexpired employment authorization
5. Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card with photograph (USCIS Form I-151 or I-551)
6. Unexpired Temporary Resident Card (USCIS Form I-688)
7. Unexpired Employment Authorization Card (USCIS Form I-688A)
8. Unexpired Reentry Permit (USCIS Form I-327)
9. Unexpired Refugee Travel Document (USCIS Form I-571)
10. Unexpired Employment Authorization Document issued by USCIS that contains a photograph

#### List B

##### Documents that Establish Identity

1. Driver's license or ID card issued by a State or outlying possession of the United States provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
2. ID card issued by Federal, State, or local government agency or entity provided it contains a photograph or information such as name, date of birth, gender, height, eye color, and address
3. School ID card with a photograph
4. Voter's registration card
5. U.S. Military card or draft record
6. Military dependent's ID card
7. U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
8. Native American tribal document
9. Driver's license issued by a Canadian government authority

##### **For persons under the age of 18 who are unable to present a document listed above**

1. School record or report card
2. Clinic, doctor, or hospital record
3. Day-care or nursery school record

##### Documents that Establish Employment Eligibility

1. Social Security card issued by the Social Security Administration (other than a card stating it is not valid for employment)

3. Original or certified copy of a birth certificate issued by a State, county, municipal authority, or outlying possession of the United States bearing an official seal
4. Native American tribal document
5. U.S. Citizen ID Card (USCIS Form I-197)
6. ID Card for use of Resident Citizen in the United States (USCIS Form I-179)
7. Unexpired employment authorization document issued by USCIS (other than those listed under List A)



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
