BWI MARSHALL AIRPORT FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

In accordance with Governor Hogan's Executive Order dated July 29, 2020 and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Transportation Security Administration's Security Directive 1582/84-21-01 dated January 31, 2021, it is **required under federal law** that masks be worn in airports, on commercial aircraft, and in various modes of surface transportation. All individuals (employees, contractors, tenants, and customers) are required to wear a face mask or face covering (non-medical mask or bandana) when entering Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall (BWI Marshall) Airport or its facilities and when utilizing BWI Marshall Airport public transportation. Physical distancing measures shall also be in place to maintain at least six-foot spacing between all individuals.
