II. DIRECTIVE STATEMENT

- A. The purpose of this Directive is to ensure that all loading bridges are kept free of obstacles and not used as storage areas.
- B. This Directive is applicable to all tenants, concessionaires, and air carriers at Baltimore/Washington International (BWI) Airport.


III. PROCEDURES

- A. All loading bridges will be kept free and clear of items and equipment to include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Wheel Chairs
- Jump-Seats
- Ramps
- Boxes
- Trash Bags

- B. All items found in loading bridges at BWI Airport will be considered abandoned property and confiscated by the Maryland Aviation Administration (MAA) personnel or Butler Aviation and retained for 15 days, at which time it will be trashed or scraped.
