Mobile Lounge Operations at BWI Marshall – Safety and Compliance

This Advisory has been issued to raise awareness for Mobile Lounge operations on the Ramps at BWI Marshall. Mobile Lounges, or PlaneMates, are large transportation vehicles utilized for the enplanement and deplanement of passengers on aircraft. To help minimize the potential for accidents and incidents, we are asking all employees to review their safety plans for Ground Vehicle Operations and pay special attention to their surroundings while completing daily tasks.



PLANEMATES have the Right of Way! Treat them like Aircraft at all times

Some facts:

- International Concourse construction has created the need for increased Mobile Lounge operations.
- BWI's Mobile Lounge fleet has doubled to four Mobile Lounges to meet the increased demand.
- Mobile Lounges have limited visibility for the driver. Just like aircraft, use caution whenever operating around them.
- Mobile Lounges require more than a single lane of traffic when operating on Vehicle Service Roads so please yield the Right-of-Way and allow them ample room to pass and maneuver.

The goal is to have a safe and efficient environment for all. Please exercise good judgment and practice situational awareness. It takes a "Team Effort" to accomplish this and we request your assistance in achieving this.
