AIRFIELD VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROGRAM VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION

Effective November 6, 2017, all vehicles operating on the airfield at BWI Marshall Airport shall have appropriate identification markings as described in Tenant Directive 200.2, Airfield Vehicle Registration Program. This Directive states:

“Unless specifically exempted by MDOT MAA, any vehicle issued an Airfield registration decal, which operate on the airfield, shall have clear identifying markings as described in Code of Maryland Regulations 11.03.01.04P.”

“Identification markings shall be plainly visible and displayed on both the left and right sides of the vehicle. Acceptable markings include permanently affixed decals, painted markings, and magnetic signs. Handmade signs are prohibited.”

“Identification markings shall be visible from a distance of 50 feet. The name of the agency shall be spelled out in letters no less than 3 inches in height.”

Requests for an exemption must be made in writing to John Stewart, Director, Office of Airport Operations, BWI Marshall Airport. The request must clearly explain why compliance with the vehicle marking and identification requirement is detrimental to your mission and reason for operating a vehicle on the airfield at BWI Marshall Airport. Temporary identification markings are acceptable and allow vehicle operators to affix and then remove markings as they enter/exit the Security Identification Display Area (SIDA).
