ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION MAINTENANCE

Maintenance is scheduled for the following electrical equipment at Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport. All tenants in the affected areas should take precautionary measures for a power outage on each of the dates listed below. In the event of a power outage, all life safety systems including fire protection and emergency lighting systems will operate as designed utilizing backup power. Affected areas: Entire Terminal including all Concourses, Central Utility Plant, Daily Garage, Hourly Garage, Airfield Lighting Vault, Apron lights, BWI Fire and Rescue Department, Runway 15R Deicing Pump Station, and Runway 28 Deicing Pump Station.
