Proposed Procedures Update

- The Roundtable requested that FAA amend the TERPZ SID due to concerns expressed by Elkridge/Columbia (RWY28) and Elkridge/Elmhurst/ Severn/Jessup/Columbia (RWY15R)
- Options Considered: Off-The-Ground, Radar Vector, and Open SIDs
- May require CONLE and FIXET SID amendments
- Community concerns regarding RWY33L arrivals, resulting from aircraft descending to low altitudes or direct SPLAT
- Consider amendments to the RAVNN-TRISH-ANTHM-MIIDY STAR for RWY33L and RWY10
- Consider amendments to TRISH–ANTHM STARs for descent and speed reduction criteria issues




Full Work Group Goals

- Goal: Maintain safe and efficient procedures that satisfies air traffic and industry requirements and consider amendments that address community concerns
- Consider amendments to the TERPZ SID, RAVNN, TRISH and ANTHM STARs
- Collaborate with air traffic, industry and MAA to consider amendments to procedures to address community concerns, and criteria requirements




FAA TERPZ RWY28






TERPZ RWY 28

Green is current / Red is notional and subject to change











BWI Project Details, TERPZ RWY15R






TERPZ RWY 15R

Green is current / Red is notional and subject to change











TERPZ RWY 28/15R

Green is current / Red is notional and subject to change












BWI Airspace Complexities















RAVVN STAR / ILS RWY 33L

Magenta is current STAR / Black is ILS











RAVVN STAR / ILS RWY 33L

Green is notional designs and subject to change











RAVVN STARs / ILS RWY 33L

Magenta is current / Green is notional and subject to change











Combined notional STARs / Victor Routes

- Any of the changes discussed above would be a new action that would be subject to full safety and environmental reviews, as required by FAA's Orders and applicable laws.

June 20, 2019 Adoption of procedure amendments would not be possible before June 20, 2019,
and would be dependent on completion of FAA's safety and environmental reviews
