The Greater Baltimore Committee (GBC) fully supports the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Aviation Administration's (MDOT MAA) application for a Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grant to help fund **the BWI Marshall Airport Roadway, Multi-Modal and Cargo Modernization Planning Study**.
