## **BGE FEEDER AND SUBSTATION UPGRADES PHASE 1**

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On August 30, 2021 at 12:01 a.m., maintenance is scheduled to perform Lock-Out/Tag-Out at the switch/breaker in Building 192C feeding Transformer T2 at the South Substation to allow for contract work. Work includes new two-inch control conduit from Building 192C along the fence line past Transformer T2 to Buildings 192A and 192B; demolition of existing light poles and bases near transformer T2; and connection/pulling of new circuitry through existing conduit. The anticipated duration of construction is 15 business days.

The outage should not affect any tenants. However, all tenants in the affected areas should take precautionary measures for a power outage during this time. In the event of a power outage, all life safety systems including fire protection and emergency lighting systems will operate as designed utilizing backup power.
