

RESOLVED, that the DC Metroplex BWI Community Roundtable asks the Maryland Aviation Administration (the “MAA”) to actively and publicly support SB 658 & HB 1101, which would establish a community advocate-controlled State Commission designed to provide legislators with the best available science-based information related to the impacts on communities of commercial aviation infrastructure in the State in order to allow them to better balance the needs of communities with the needs of the commercial aviation industry and its traditional stakeholders.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair is authorized and empowered in the name of the Roundtable to deliver a letter to the chief executive officer of the MAA describing our request and seeking a written response within a specific timeframe to be determined in the sole and absolute determination of the Chair.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair shall deliver this letter to the MAA without seeking approval of it from the full voting membership of the Roundtable in advance.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair shall provide the Roundtable with copies via email of all communication with the MAA as soon as practicable in the spirit of fully informing the Roundtable of the communications between the Roundtable and the MAA on this matter.
