SUBSTATION MAINTENANCE

Maintenance is scheduled for the following electrical equipment at Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport. All tenants in the affected areas should take precautionary measures for a power outage on each of the dates listed below. The known outages provide a good opportunity for tenants to test UPS systems. If security systems are affected, contractor will arrange for alternate power prior to the commencement of work. In the event of a power outage, all life safety systems including fire protection and emergency lighting systems will operate as designed utilizing backup power.
